THE STANDARDS OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1986*

No. 75 of 1986

[25th December, 1986]

An Act to amend the Standards of Weights and Measures Act, 1976.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the 'Thirty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:

Short title and commencement

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Standards of Weights and Measures (Amendment) Act, 1986.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

Amendment of section 72

- 2. In section 72 of the Standards of Weights and Measures Act, 1976, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:
 - (a) no court shall take cognizance of an offence punishable under this Act except upon a complaint, in writing, made by:
 - (i) the Director;
 - (ii) any other authorised officer;
 - (iii) any person aggrieved; or
 - (iv) a recognised consumer association whether the person aggrieved is a member of such association or not.

'Explanation.—For the purposes of this clause "recognised consumer association" means a voluntary consumer association registered under the Companies Act, 1956 or any other law for the time being in force'.
