OFFICE ORDER NO. 22

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 (1) (a) of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 (68 of 1986), the Central Government hereby appoints Mr. Justice V.B. Eradi, retired Judge of the Supreme Court of India as President of the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission with effect from the date he assumes charge of the post.

2. The terms and conditions of his appointment will be as follows:
- (i) his appointment shall be for a period of three years or till he attains the age of 70 years, whichever is earlier;
 - (ii) subject to the rules governing the payment of pension to the retired Judges of the Supreme Court he will be entitled to the salary, allowances and other perquisites as admissible to a sitting Judge of the Supreme Court of India;
 - (iii) the other terms and conditions of his service shall be regulated in accordance with the provisions of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 read with the Consumer Protection Rules, 1987 as amended from time to time.
