ORDER

Shri B.R. Zaiwalla, learned counsel for the defendant files a copy of a certified copy of the order in the order-sheet dated 21.1.1988, passed by the Hon'ble High Court in C.R. No. 26/1988. This Court has not yet received authentic copy directly. Mr. Vepa Sarthy, learned counsel for the plaintiff admits that such an order was passed.

In view of the order of the Hon'ble High Court as stated above, this Court shall now hear and dispose of the matters relating to incorporation of particulars by way of amendments in the plaint and written statement so as to complete the pleadings but shall not proceed to hear any other matters till the disposal of Revision. petition No. 26/1988.

I.A. No. 29 :-

This is an application made by the plaintiff for amendment of the plaint to furnish particulars ordered by this Court on 21.12.1987. The application is considered. It is not opposed also. It is allowed. Plaint be amended accordingly.

Shri Zaiwalla, learned counsel for the defendant files an application (*I.A. No. 30*) for consequential amendment of the written-statement. Copy has been supplied to the other side.

The application is taken up for consideration. Parties heard. The proposed amendment is consequential in nature and is necessary to answer the particulars supplied by the plaintiff by way of amendment including those under (*I.A. No. 29*).

The application is not opposed by the plaintiff and being consequential in nature, is allowed.

Both the parties are directed to file amended plaint and written statement with the amended portion underlined in red ink so as to decipher the original allegations from those introduced by way of amendment. This is naturally bound to take sometime. The amended copies shall be filed within a fortnight.
