


PREFACE

Embarked upon the broad principle of cultivation of science of law, the Indian Law Institute publishes studies, treatises, books, reports and other literatures relating to law and allied fields. The Institute has uninterruptedly published Journal of Indian Law Institute, Annual Survey of Indian Law and other publications such as books on Legal Research and Methodology, Labour Law and Labour Relations, Indian Legal System etc. The Institute has been a forerunner in disseminating legal information and is considered to be a national and international center for legal research and studies. The library of the Institute is considered to be one of the best resourceful libraries in the field of law and it receives about three hundred legal periodicals annually.

The Institute has been publishing Index to Indian Legal Periodicals from 1963 onwards. It is a yearly publication which is used by law students, researchers, academicians and member of bar and bench as a research tool for an up-to-date, exhaustive and extensive research. The Index is broadly divided into two parts, while the first part is an index to Indian Periodicals; the second part is index to Foreign Articles. The first part indexes Indian articles on the basis of subject headings, subject index, author index and subject/keyword index. The second part indexes the foreign articles on the basis of subject index and subject headings. The searching mechanism is simple and consists of an alphabetical list of subjects and authors that refers to entries where in title, sub-title, author, name of the periodical, month, issue no., volume no. and page no. have been mentioned. The author index and the subject/keyword index have a corresponding number which indicates the serial number of the article in the index.

The index is prepared by Mr. Bhag Singh, Librarian with the assistance of Mr. Nitin Bansal, Library Assistant and Ms. Ritu Pal, Jr. Library Assistant of the Institute.
