ACT No. IX OF 1912.<sup>1</sup>

**An Act further to amend the Presidency Small Cause Courts Act, 1882.**

**XV of 1882.** WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Presidency Small Cause Courts Act, 1882; It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Presidency Small Cause Courts Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1912.

**XV of 1882.** 2. In section 41 of the Presidency Small Cause Courts Act, 1882, for the word " one " the word " two " shall be substituted. Amendment of section 41, Act XV, 1882.

**An Act further to amend the Indian Divorce Act.**

**IV of 1889.** WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Divorce Act; It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Indian Divorce (Amendment) Act, Short title. 1912.

**IV of 1889.** 2. To section 7 of the Indian Divorce Act the following proviso shall be added, namely :— Addition to section 7, Act IV, 1889.

“ Provided that nothing in this section shall deprive the said Courts of jurisdiction in a case where the parties to a marriage professed the Christian religion at the time of the occurrence of the facts on which the claim to relief is founded.”
